Stella Adler Technique

Like the adult classes at Stella Adler Studio-Los Angeles, the core of the teen program is Ms. Adler's acting technique. Students in the teen program will learn to use their imagination in both improvised and planned exercises. Through these exercises and games, the students sharpen their awareness of themselves and of those around them. Students will be introduced to the basic precepts of Stella's technique, and be taught how to honestly communicate their ideas and bring their characters to life on stage.

About Adam Bitterman

Adam Bitterman earned his BFA at the NYU/Tisch School of the Arts where he studied at the Adler Conservatory with Stella Adler and Alice Winston, among others. He earned a directing internship at The Royal Court Theater in London, England, where he studied under Artistic Director Max Stafford-Clarke and director Simon Curtis. He also studied Practical Aesthetics with the technique's developers David Mamet, William H. Macy and the (then) newly formed Atlantic Theater Company. After moving to Los Angeles he helped found the award-winning Sacred Fools Theater, where he produced the hits *43 Plays For 43 Presidents*; *Dracula, A Musical Nightmare* and *Dubya 2004*; and directed the multiple award-winning comedy Nicholas Debeaubien's *The Hunchback of Notre Dame*. As an actor, Adam has won critical praise for his performances in the plays *A Pound of Flesh*, *Mad Boy Chronicle* and *Heaven*, to name a few. He has been seen in episodes of VERONICA MARS; SCRUBS; BUFFY, THE VAMPIRE SLAYER; and EARLY EDITION; as well as in the films LOOK, BOARDWALK POETS, DENIAL and THINGS CHANGE.
